

## **GUIDELINES FOR SPONSORED REGISTRATIONS FOR AUTHORS OF ACCEPTED ABSTRACTS & INVITED SYMPOSIA SPEAKERS**

Deadline for applying is **8 August by 23:59 CEST**

### **Who is eligible to apply:**

The Union is pleased to offer 100 sponsored registrations for The Union World Conference on Lung Health 2022. Individuals from low- and lower-middle income countries will be given priority, as will those who are presenting at the conference, including invited speakers and presenters of abstracts (oral presentations and e-posters) and symposia presentations who would be unable to participate without support.

### **Who will review the applications:**

The applications will be reviewed by members of The Union Coordinating Committee of Scientific Activities (CCSA), TBScience Scientific Committee and The Union Department heads and teams.

### **Minimum eligibility criteria:**

Currently working or volunteering for a programme or research project in lung health.

### **Application process:**

By the stated deadline (8 August), applicants must complete the application, submit a motivation letter as outlined below (formats accepted are, PDF, doc, docx):

1. One-page letter of motivation including the following points (please note that CVs will not be accepted or reviewed):
  - a) Your current activities in lung health
  - b) Your contribution to virtual conference
  - c) Your plans for disseminating the knowledge you gain at the conference

**Applications are open from:** 18 July

### **Responsibilities of sponsored registration recipients:**

Share feedback and experiences with The Union CCSA in the post-conference report and work with Communications to engage on social media during and after the conference (more details will be shared with successful applicants).
