

GUIDELINES FOR SPONSORED REGISTRATION FOR CIVIL SOCIETY MEMBERS & INDIVIDUALS WORKING IN LUNG HEALTH

Deadline for applying is: 11 August by 23:59 CEST

Who is eligible to apply:

The Union is pleased to offer 100 sponsored registrations for to The Union World Conference on Lung Health 2022 to civil society members and individuals involved in efforts to address lung health. Individuals from low- and lower-middle income countries will be given priority, as will those who are presenting at the conference, including in the Community Connect programme.

Please note this process does not apply to invited speakers or authors of accepted abstracts. Speakers and authors should read the sponsored registration guidelines before applying for assistance.

Who will review the applications:

Applications for sponsored registration will be reviewed by The Union Community Advisory Panel (UCAP) and members of The Union's Coordinating Committee of Scientific Activities (CCSA).

Minimum eligibility criteria:

- Members of civil society working with those affected by lung disease
- Individuals involved in efforts to address lung health

By the stated deadline (11 August), applicants must complete the application and submit a motivation letter, as outlined below (formats accepted are PDF, .doc, and .docx):

1. A maximum one-page letter of motivation outlining the following:
 - a. Why you want to participate in the Union Conference 2022
 - b. How your participation in the conference will benefit your organisation and/or community and/or your own personal/professional development

Applications are opened from: 18 July
